



The Ercros factory in Tortosa, awarded for its job security



The Ercros factory in Tortosa has been awarded, for a second consecutive year, with the Feique Safety Award, given by the Business Federation of the Spanish Chemical Industry (Feique) for not having had any accidents among its own personnel throughout 2020.

This good result in terms of safety is due, to a large extent, to the involvement of the people who work in the factory and to the periodic awareness campaigns that are carried out.

This centre is registered in the register of the EU environmental management and audit scheme (EMAS); has the environmental management certified according to the ISO 14001 standard; the management of occupational safety according to the ISO 45001 standard; quality management according to ISO 9001; and its CO_2 emissions verified according to the ISO 14064 standard.

The Tortosa factory is part of the intermediate chemicals division. It directly employs 114 people and in 2020 had a turnover of 64 million euros. It exports 73% of its sales to more than 50 countries around the world and is one of the world's leading producers of polyols (pentaerythritol, dipentaerythritol and sodium formate). The R&D department of the intermediate chemicals division is located in this centre.
